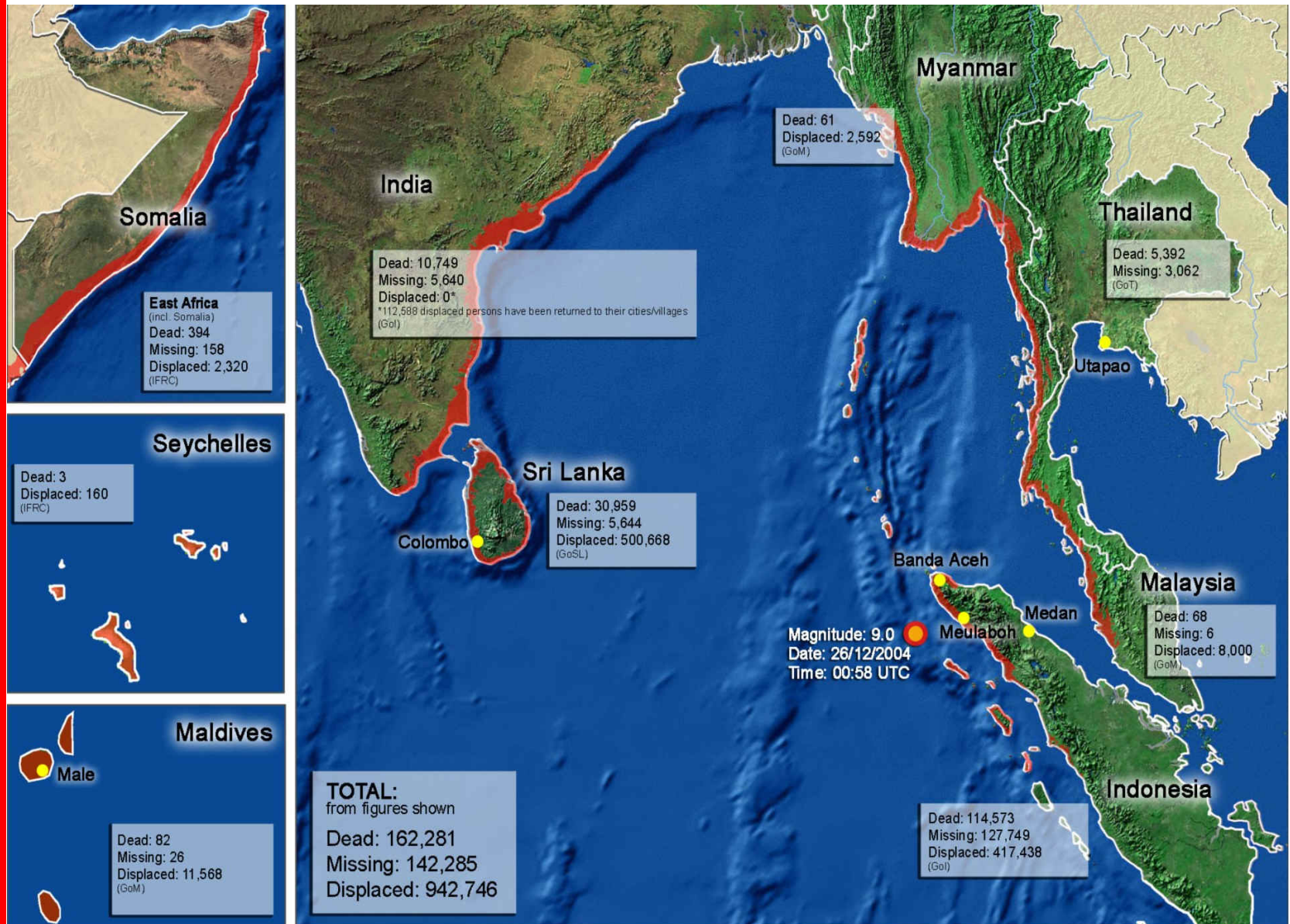

26/12/2004 09:30 CET 19:00 local time	Boxing Day Alerting of General Secretariat of ECOM (Emergency Corps Order of Malta) Start of first relief actions through partners in India (Help for One Million/HOM)
27/12/2004	Malteser staff from North Thailand arrive in Phuket/Thailand start of main assessment in India and Thailand
28/12/2004	Expansion of relief measures to the whole southern coast of India Myanmar rejects relief offer
30/12/2004	Preparation of assessment in Sri Lanka preparation of shipping of medicine to Sri Lanka
04/01/2005	Leave of assessment team to Sri Lanka

08-16/02/2005	Visit of international delegates of the Order of Malta to the Tsunami affected areas in India and Thailand under the direction of H.E. the Grand Hospitaller

**Thailand:  
immediate relief**



provision of fishermen with relief items

provision of General Hospital with medical equipment and medicine

provision of 500 IDPs in Camp near Bang Sak with vital goods like stoves, charcoal, blankets etc.

provision of a Children Day Care Centre with supply goods and construction material

provision of Thai Muang Community Hospital with medical equipment and medicine

Psychosocial support and medical assistance at the airport

Finance of transport of 60 to of lime for disinfection purposes

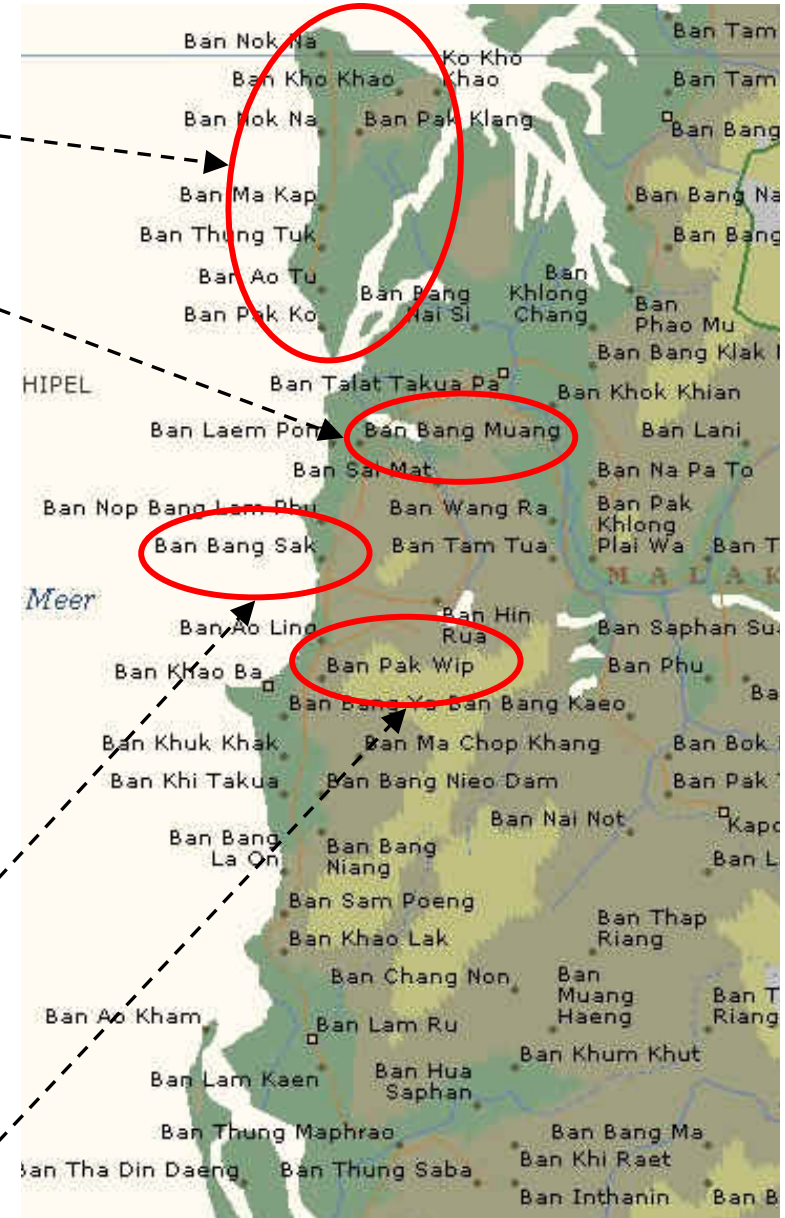

# Relief for Tsunami affected areas

## Thailand: planned projects



Construction of 50 houses incl. water & sanitation on Kho Khao Island

Provision of boat engines and flues for 800 fishermen (whole region)

Construction of 30 houses

estimated budget:  
Immediate relief: 300.000 €  
First reconstruction phase: 1 million €

immediate relief: 400.000 €

Reconstruction phase 1: 1.5 - 2 million €

Construction of 500 temporary shelter (SAHAYI)

Reconstruction of 350 houses in three villages (HOM)

Rotating finance fund for fishermen cooperative

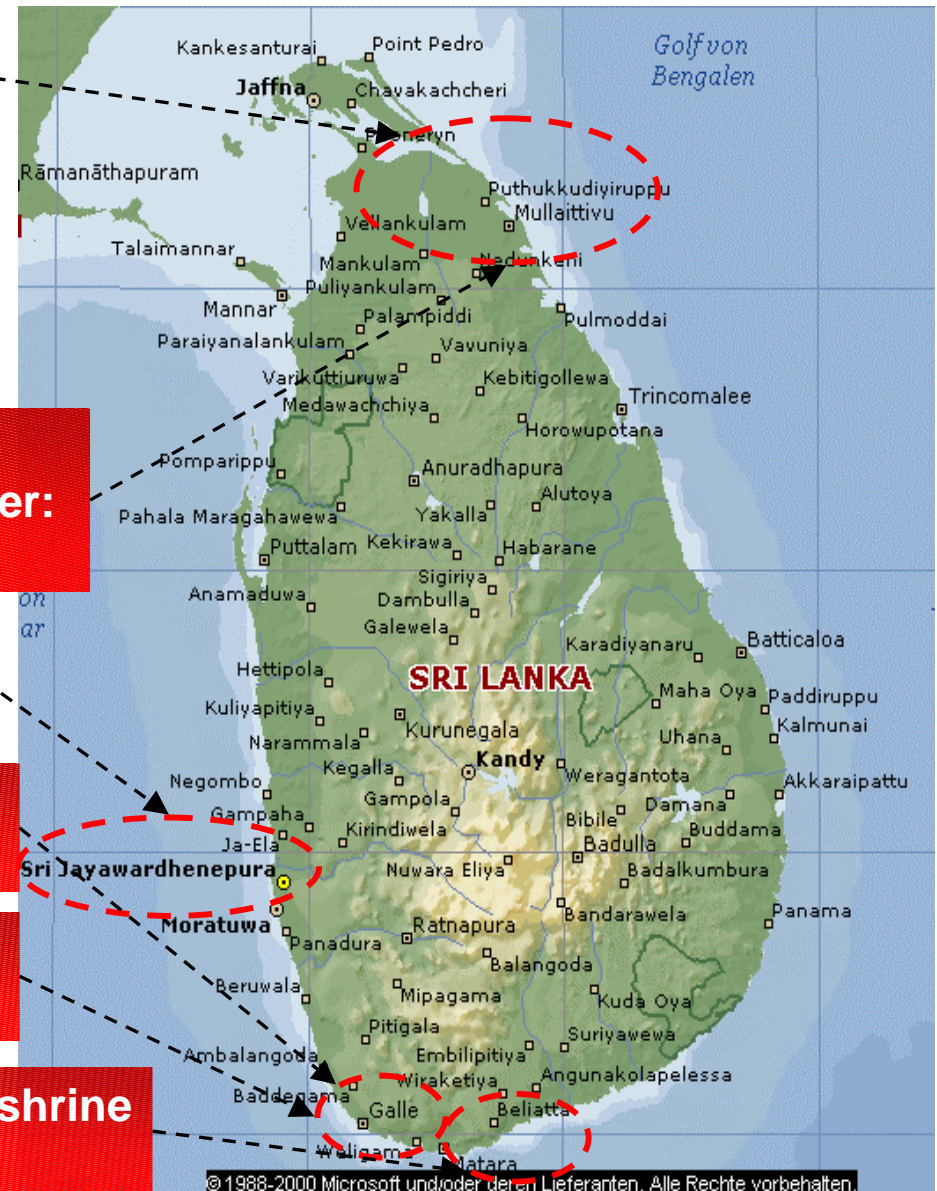

# Relief for Tsunami affected areas

## Sri Lanka: planned projects



Extension of boys home

Provision of 200 fishermen with boats, engines and flues

Community rehabilitation programme:  
Reconstruction of 100 houses,  
improvement of infrastructure,  
basic household effects for families

Rehabilitation of an orphanage (TRO)

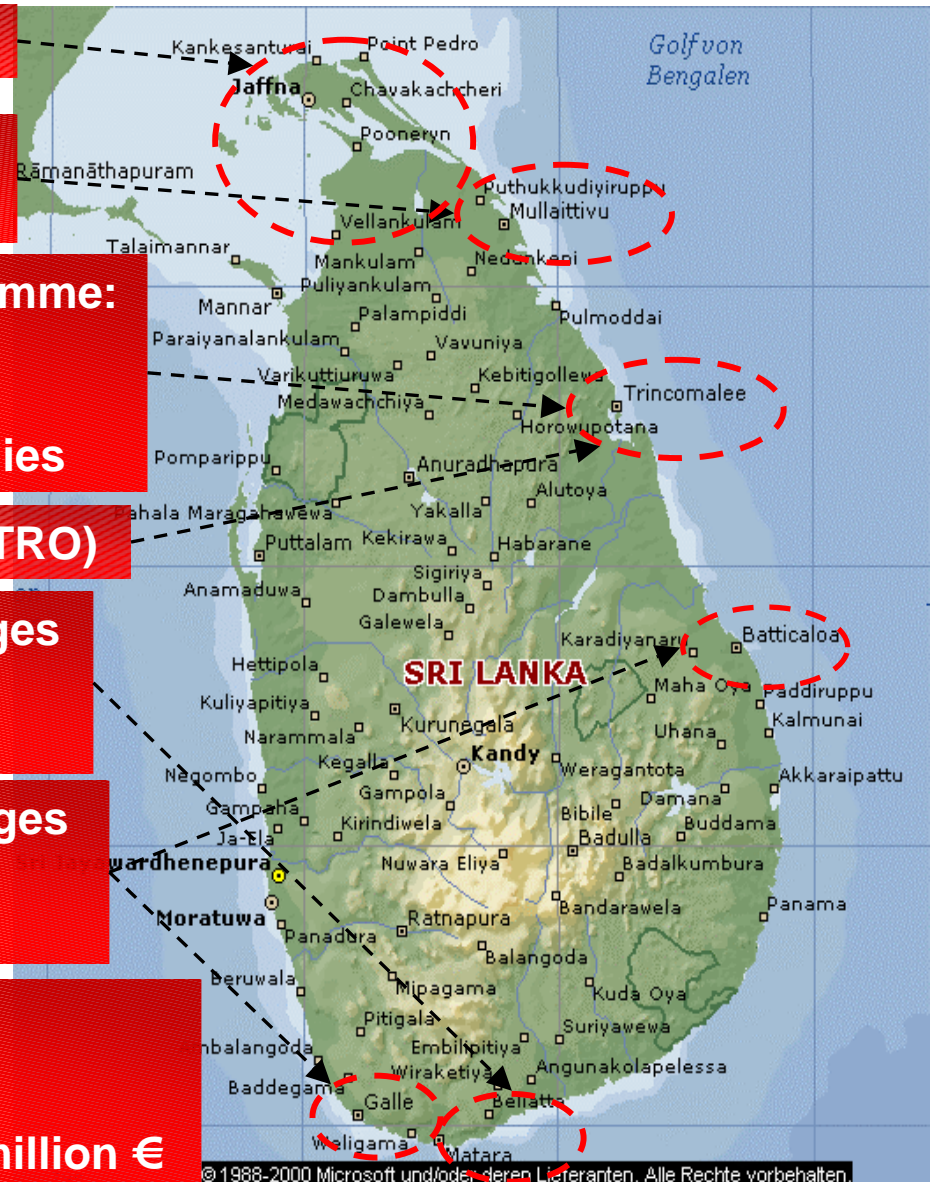
Reconstruction of 5 fishing villages  
incl. WatSan, fishing boats, etc;  
partner: GTZ (Tangalle)

Reconstruction of at least 5 villages  
and psychosocial support;  
partner: Help for the Children

### estimated budget

Immediate relief: 250.000 €

First reconstruction phase: 2-3 million €

1. The focus of our work is **health care, water & sanitation** and **shelter**.
2. The affected countries are **self-confident** and **capable**. Foreign help is not always wanted. Thus, we cooperate closely with our **local partner organisations**.
3. Material and supply goods will be purchased **locally** if possible.
4. Malteser prepares to participate in the reconstruction phase for the next **3 to 5 years**.
